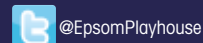

Reserved tickets will be held for 4 days. In common with standard theatre practice tickets cannot be exchanged or money refunded. There is a £1.20 charge for each ticket lost or replaced. Please check your tickets at the time of purchase/receipt as mistakes cannot be rectified at a later date. The management reserves the right to change or amend the programme without prior notice.

Drinking glasses/bottles and china are not allowed in the main Auditorium. The taking of photographs or recording any part of the programme is strictly prohibited. Please remember to switch off your mobile phone. The management reserves the right to refuse admission. The Playhouse is fully equipped with an infrared loop system. Please let us know your requirements when booking your tickets. Under 13's will not be admitted without an adult.

Parking

The Ashley Centre Car Park. Parking from 4.00pm weekdays, 6.00pm Saturdays to 5.00am is currently £1.50 per visit. On Sundays the first 2 hours is £1.00, over 2 hours is £1.50. Please note The Ashley Centre lifts do not operate outside the shopping hours.
