Job title: Casual Assistant Skate Tutor **Reporting and accountable to:** Lead Skate Tutor (UYA)

Working hours: Hours will be offered as and when they become available, although there is no guarantee of any hours being made available. Casual tutors do not have to accept any offers of work but once accepted it is expected that the commitment will be honoured. Hours likely to be available could be daytime, evening or weekend.

Responsibilities:

- To assist the Lead Skate Tutor to work with young people in schools and in community venues teaching skateboarding, in-line skating and scootering. Some of the young people you will work with will be at risk of exclusion and/or at risk of antisocial behaviour and/or offending or will have other extra support needs.
- To assist to set up and dismantle UYA's mobile skate ramps at indoor and outdoor venues in the London and Surrey areas.
- Some events will be supported by UYA's volunteers and you will be required to work with them to deliver the sessions.
- To undergo training in order to operate equipment
- To be a positive representative of UYA with children and young people at events and with staff from hosting organisations.

This post will require an enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check due to the nature of the work.
