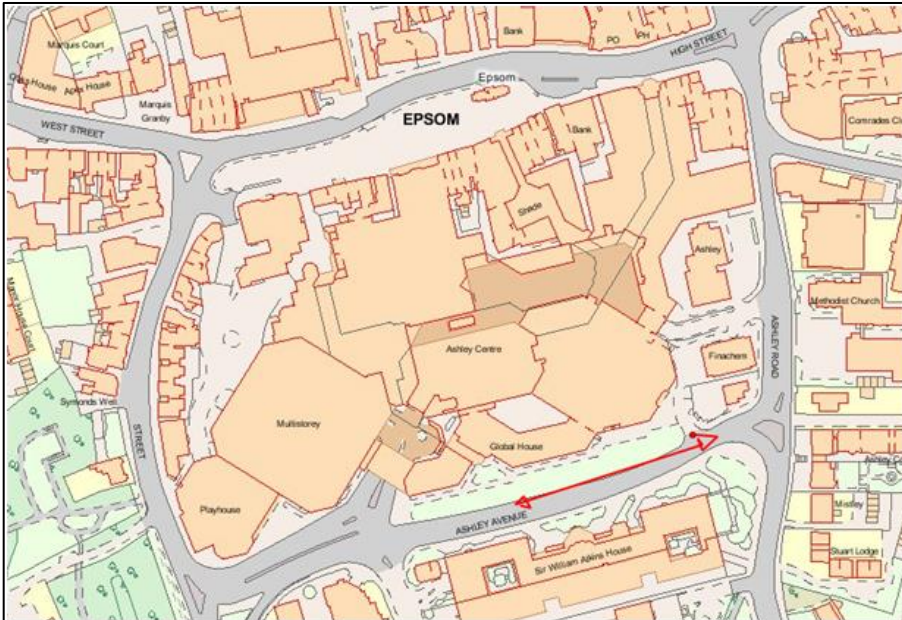

What are we going to do?

- We are building a new bus stand in Ashley Avenue which will replace the current bus stand in the High Street.

- This project will change the road layout in Epsom to help reduce congestion and improve the town centre's appearance.

Information for residents and businesses

The traffic management for this work will be removed during the morning and evening peak hours to ease congestion. We know that traffic flow through Epsom is critical, and even a minor incident can create major disruption. So we are planning the works carefully with our contractor and SCC's Traffic Signals team to try and minimise the impact.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.
