ME?



All 3 and 4 year old children can have 15 hours funded early education a week over 38 weeks of the year.

That's 570 hours every year until they start school. Some childcare providers offer fewer hours each week that can be taken over more weeks of the year. Some working families get an extra 15 hours a week of funded childcare - so up to 30 in all!

For children who turn 3 between:	... the funded childcare starts from:
1 January to 31 March	April (Summer term)
1 April to 31 August	September (Autumn term)
1 September to 31 December	January (Spring term)

Can my family get the additional 15 hours?

Find out more and apply through the government's www.childcarechoices.gov.uk website.

If you are eligible you'll get a code (number) from this website to take to your childcare provider. You must get your code before three possible start dates which are either 1 April, 1 September or 1 January.

Where can I get my childcare?

At any Ofsted registered day nursery, pre-school, school nursery, childminder or out of school club. The choice will depend on what's available in your local area.

You can use your funded hours:

- with more than one provider; and
- for up to 10 hours a day between 6am and 8pm.

Can your 2 year old get 15 hours of funded childcare a week during school term time? To find out visit www.suffolk.gov.uk/two if you get any:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment Support Allowance
- Support through Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- State Pension Credit (the guaranteed element)
- Child Tax Credit and /or Working Tax Credit and earn no more than £16,190 per year
- Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit and earn no more than £15,400, based on your earnings in the last three monthly assessment periods

Claiming a funded place for your two year old will not affect your other benefits.

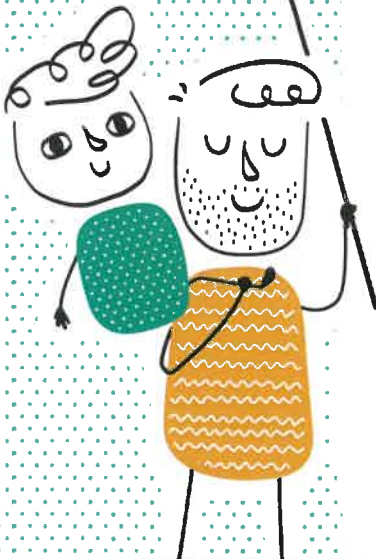
Once your child starts a place they remain eligible even if your circumstances change.

Golden Tickets:

If you receive one of the above benefits a Golden Ticket may be posted to you. Please bring this ticket with you when you want to claim your funded childcare.

Or take proof to your chosen childcare provider that your child:

- Has left care through Special Guardianship, or through an Adoption, Residence or Child Arrangements Order
- Is a Child in Care (CiC) (Looked After Child)
- Has a current Education, Health and Care Plan
- Receives Disability Living Allowance



FUNDED CHILDCARE AT TWO

How will the funded 15 hours per week childcare benefit my 2 year old?

Your child will receive quality early learning opportunities which will allow them to develop their skills, explore and make friends in a fun and safe environment.

Where can I get my funded childcare?

Your child can receive their 15 hours funded childcare with an Ofsted registered early years provider who offers funded 2 year old places, such as a day nursery, pre-school playgroup or a childminder.

When can I start receiving funded childcare for my eligible 2 year old?

Children who are eligible can receive their funded childcare from the beginning of the term after their second birthday. Please refer to the table below:

A child who turns two between:	Is eligible for a funded place from:
1 January to 31 March	April (Summer term)
1 April to 31 August	September (Autumn term)
1 September to 31 December	January (Spring term)
