JULIE'S JAUNTS

I visited Sudbury's Heritage Centre at the Town Hall to see the *NEW* screen presentation that links Sudbury's bunting industry with the flag that inspired the American national anthem. This to me is the most fascinating fact about the history of Sudbury. I once accompanied a blue badge guide on a guided walk of the town and I heard a gentleman say when he heard this fact "Sudbury truly is the centre of the universe!"



But....there is so much more and always something new to learn. There are photographs and details of Sudbury's silk history. You'll find out that Sudbury is the Capital of silk in the UK because we have 4 working silk mills and 110 tonnes of raw silk come into Sudbury each year to be woven into cloth. This year on Saturday 7th September, Sudbury will have its very 1st silk festival to celebrate all that is silk. Visit www.sudburysilkfestival.org for all the latest news

There are also old photographs of the shops and buildings some are taken 100 years ago. Sudbury also like other towns contributed in many ways to the 2 world wars. The museum has the individual stories of some of these men who died fighting for their country.

Children are fascinated by the story of 101 Dalmatians whose author Dodie Smith wrote the book in 1956 and mentions Sudbury. Dodie lived nearby and was often in town shopping especially on market days.



Read about the story of Archbishop Simon of Sudbury and see the reconstruction of his head. His mummified head is in St. Gregory's church where it was brought back to Sudbury after his head was cut off at the Tower of London by the revolting peasants in 1381.



The Heritage Centre is completely free and there are also free quiz sheets for children to become detectives and solve all the clues.

It is situated at the back of the Town Hall in Gaol Lane and is open during normal office hours on weekdays 9am – 5pm and on Saturdays 10am – 12.30pm.

Here at the Tourist Information we have monthly guided walking tours of the town – the 3rd Saturday of the month. Our next walk is the 17th August. Why not join us at 11am, do the tour, see Simon's mummified head in St. Gregory's church and then visit the museum.

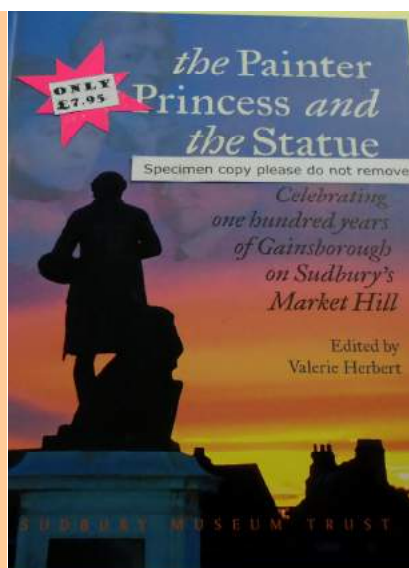
