JULIE'S JAUNTS

Having an allotment, I love this time of year when all that work pays off and you get to enjoy the fruits of your labour. Now it's one thing growing your own fruit and vegetables, but if you get it wrong in the kitchen then it could quickly become a waste of effort, time and money.

At the Sudbury Food Festival this year I happened upon the stall for The Foragers Retreat, which was offering topped rounds of baguette, but the toppings were all produced themselves and where possible, were from foraged ingredients. I recall we brought a few rounds and decided that a visit to their premises in Pebmarsh was definitely in order.



The venture started with a pop up restaurant a couple of days a week on the top floor of The Quay Theatre, you may recall it was so popular that there was a three month wait for a table! Well, they have now found permanent premises for their business with a café, bar and Shillingfords' Restaurant.

Pebmarsh is a pretty village just over the border and takes approximately 15 minutes to reach by car or 45 minutes cycling or by bus.

The perfect occasion came when we had visitors for a long weekend, culminating in a birthday for Alison, so we set off on a rainy Monday lunchtime to find The Foragers Retreat.

The premises are set in an old farmyard, where the village shop is also based. The parking was right outside the café in front of the outside seating area, which wasn't being used in view of the cold and wet weather. We received a pleasant welcome from the uniformed staff and were given an overview of how things worked. Menus were on clipboards hanging behind us, specials were written above them on chalkboards, cutlery underneath and we should order at the bar. So we set off upstairs, where the more formal dining space was and settled down to choose our dishes. We decided on a variety of sharing dishes so we could graze and as Alison had special dietary requirements, we made sure that there were some vegetarian and dairy free options to choose from. I popped back downstairs to order and mentioned that we had a birthday in the group.



I would recommend making a trip over for lunch, between us we had boards of a smoked meat, fish and cheese, a soul bowl, which was salad with the most wonderful dressing with two vegetable dishes from the selection on offer. This was completed by the hummus, olives and copious amounts of baguette. When our food arrived, the staff had pleasingly put some candles on one of the dishes, which was a nice touch.

The building is rustic, with that old world farming charm and barn-conversion feel, although the furnishings downstairs are Turkish in appearance. They have their own smokehouse in the yard outside and you can just tell that the chef has a passion for the food they are preparing.

The only thing left to say is.....when can I fit in a visit to Shillingfords' Restaurant!

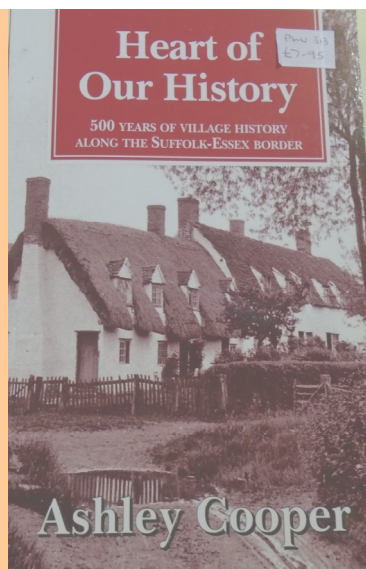
